Soundcheck:

Whilst I realise that this is considered unimportant for DJ's, in fact some venues don't even bother with bands, I'd be happier if you'd allow me a minute or three just to check the decks. Thanks!

Equipment:

I'm a man of simple pleasures, give me a good quality twin CD deck, a decent mixer and a loud PA and I'm happy, some space in the booth for CD cases though is very important! I use cases, with proper CD's in them.

I do have my own decks if needed, and if the event is in the UK, I will require a 2x 8mm jack inputs to the PA (one for each channel). I would prefer to not have to use them, but if there is no other choice, I will ask that you cover the cost of transportation. This may include a cab or getting a lift to and from a hotel if I'm staying in one near the venue (they're a bit heavy!).

Extras:

A spare plug socket for lamps in the DJ booth is also required; I'll bring my own extension lead and lamps, but if you can provide spares 'just in case' then that might be a good idea.

Food:

If I'd had to travel any longer than three hours to get to you then I'd ask that you either provide a little food (crisps, nuts, a sandwich, nothing fancy) or pay a £5.00 buyout for me to sort this out myself.

Drinks:

They need to be cold. A six pack of decent beer or 6 drink tickets (I'm not fussy, lager is fine if it's not Stella), and some bottled water (6 half litre bottles), will do fine, thanks!

Guest List:

I will require at least one guest pass, more is nice but not essential.
